

2009 4 Cylinder Stock Compact Rules

What's Eligible?

- Any two wheel drive, four cylinder, front or wheel rear wheel drive car with a maximum wheelbase of 106 inches
- Cars can only be carbureted or fuel injected – No turbo or high performance cars will be allowed.
- **Duel overhead cams will now be allowed.**

Rules

- Everything must remain stock, be in original position and must be original equipment for the year, make, and model of the car.
- Safety add-ons such as racing seats, roll bars, and fuel cells are allowed.
- Everything must remain stock, including the engine, transmission, shifter, front and rear suspension, pedals, dashboard, steering column, carburetion or fuel ejection, battery location, and air cleaning housing.
- All tires and rims must be the same DOT original size and type. No aftermarket wheels or high performance tires.
- Exhaust – Muffler converter may be removed. Exhaust pipe must extend past the driver.
- All chrome, molding, installation, carpeting, and extra seats must be removed. Webbing for the hood, trunk, roof, door, and inner fender wells must remain in place.
- No removing or adding weight to cars.
- Windshields are allowed or can be replaced with wire mesh with a brace in the center.
- Driver's door must be welded or chained shut. Also can be gutted if using an internal door brace. Driver's door window netting is mandatory.
- Gas tank in front of the rear axles may remain in stock location. If it is behind the rear axles, it must be replaced with fuel cell or boat tank that is not more than 6.6 gallons. If needs to be securely fastened in the trunk behind the firewall.

Safety Requirements

- Quick release window net on the driver's side is mandatory.
- Snell approved helmet with goggles or shield is mandatory.
- Coveralls, gloves, leather boots are required, however a fire suit is highly recommended.
- Driver's door protection with padding, plate bars, etc is required.
- 5 point racing harness is required.
- Roll bar or bars are required for rollover protection only – not for strengthening of the car.
- Racing seat is highly recommended.
